

Upskilling Existing Workers in Skills for Sustainability program



Small-medium Enterprise Subsidies for “Lean and Green” Manufacturing Practices

Perth based Businesses can now access training subsidies of \$1125 per person to upskill existing workers in skills for sustainability.

Is my business eligible?

To receive the funding you must be a small or medium sized business with less than 200 employees.

Subsidies of \$1125 per worker are available, with enterprises contributing \$375 per worker (a 75/25 ratio).

Existing worker participants must hold an existing accredited Australian vocational qualification to qualify for the subsidy.

How is the training provided?

Your employees will participate in an initial 1 day training program, followed by a workplace based improvement project where they must improve the environmental and energy efficiency of the workplace.

Additional coach visits are included for support, and a presentation is required summarising the results on a second training day within 3 months from commencement.

About the Program.

The Upskilling Existing Workers in Skills for Sustainability project aims to build the capacity of the Australian workforce to remain productive during the transition to a low carbon economy.

The manufacturing industry needs to ensure it has the skills to:

- maximise efficiencies and minimise waste at all levels of production
- innovate new, more energy efficient and environmentally sustainable products, processes and technologies
- establish efficient international supply chains
- monitor and report on emissions

The Improve Group has obtained approval to trial the project in selected small to medium enterprises in the Perth region.
